Title: The Impact of Title I Funding on District Fiscal Behavior

The paper investigates the effects of Title I funding on district-level financing behavior in the United States. Title I is the largest federally funded education program, designed to support districts with a high proportion of students in poverty. Using a stacked regression discontinuity design, I estimated the effects of Title I eligibility on district revenues and expenditures. The findings suggest that there is no clear evidence that Title I reduces local funding efforts. However, I find that Title I funding is associated with a decrease in capital expenditures and fewer bond elections. The results contribute to a better understanding of how federal education policies influence local financial decisions.
