

Clinical Educator Expectations Methods Field Experience

UD Methods Clinical Educators are Expected to...

- Participate in an ORIENTATION MEETING with the UD Methods Coordinator online (or watch the video recording of the meeting
- Provide opportunities for your methods student(s) to work with students and assist with classroom responsibilities
- Meet and communicate with your UD methods student(s) to clarify assignments, share expectations that you have, and to assist with topic/lesson selections
- Provide assistance to the methods student(s) in planning and implementing lessons
- Allow the methods student(s) to teach lessons that were developed in their methods courses at UD
- Observe at least 2 of the methods student(s) lessons and record noticings and constructive feedback
- Share the written feedback with methods student(s) and generate discussion about their teaching decisions, actions, and language that impacted students' learning, behavior, and/or attitudes
- Clinical educators MUST maintain responsibility for their classrooms. Methods student(s) are NOT to be left in sole charge of a class for any extended period of time
- Communicate concerns or questions related to the methods student(s) and/or the experience to your UD field supervisor
- Refrain from involvement with any other preservice teacher programs on the days that the methods student(s) are scheduled in your classroom
- Complete a brief online evaluation for EACH methods student during the mid and final weeks of the experience
- Complete an exit survey providing feedback of the experience
