## **Field Experience Assignment(s):**

#### Week 5 of the semester:

- 1. **Observation Protocol 1:** During the first two weeks, observe student learning for at least 15 minutes each day and use the protocol document to take notes. These notes will be used to create reflections (see Canvas for assignment description)
- 2. Decoding Intervention:
  - **a.** Administer and score the Informal Decoding Inventory (IDI).
  - **b.** Administer and score the Test of Letter Names and Test of Letter Sounds
  - c. Administer and score the Test of Fry Instant Words.
  - **d.** Bring these data to class on 9/16.

#### Week 6 of the semester:

- **2. Observation Protocol 1:** Continue to observe student learning for at least 15 minutes each day and use the protocol document to take notes. These notes will be used to create reflections (see Canvas for assignment description)
- **3. RTI/MTSS & Tier 3 Interventions:** Collect information about RTI/MTSS and Tier 3 interventions at your school. What does RTI look like in your school? How are assessments used and decisions made? What tier 3 intervention is used for literacy in your school? Use the RTI and Tier 3 documents to take notes.

### Week 8 of the semester: FULL TEACHING WEEK 10/14-10-18

**1. Teach your Decoding Intervention:** Teach all of your lessons and conduct your assessment. Reflect on the implementation (see description of Decoding Intervention assignment).

#### Week 9 of the semester:

- 1. Administer writing prompt and collect writing samples: Deliver a writing prompt and collect the student samples (you will determine the prompt in class).
- 2. Confer with teacher to determine writing instruction (lessons) based on data from writing prompt and samples:
  - Sentence composing
  - o Informative Text
  - o Persuasive Text
  - Narrative Text

1. Teach Writing Intervention: Teach all five lessons and collect graphic organizers.
